

Documents required for issuing an invitation to enter the Russian Federation and extending a study visa

The invitation of foreign citizens in all areas of the university's international activities and the extension of study visas is carried out by the Department for Recruitment, Support and Academic Mobility of foreign students of GASU through the Migration Department of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Altai Republic.

ISSUING AN INVITATION TO A FOREIGN CITIZEN TO ENTER THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

The list of documents for issuing an invitation to a foreign citizen:

- Completed questionnaire of the invited person (in Russian, in English);
- A copy of the invited person's passport (all pages), which should not expire earlier than six months after the end date of the intended stay. In cases where the invitation is issued for the purpose of studying at educational institutions, the validity period of the identity document of the invited foreign citizen must not expire earlier than 1.5 years from the start date of the intended stay. The processing time for the invitation is 30 to 40 calendar days from the moment the documents are submitted to the Department for Recruitment, Support and Academic Mobility of foreign students. Upon receiving the original invitation form, a foreign citizen applies to the Consulate General of the Russian Federation in the country of residence, where a visa is issued for him to enter the territory of the Russian Federation.

EXTENSION OF A STUDY VISA

List of documents for extending a study visa:

- Original of the valid foreign passport and photocopies of all its pages (from the first to the last);
- Original of the migration registration slip and its photocopy on both sides;
- Original of the migration card and its photocopy on both sides;
- Original of the study contract and its photocopy on both sides;
- Tear-off part of the arrival notification (issued upon registration for migration).
- Original receipt for the payment of the state fee in the amount of 1,600 rubles (payment details can be obtained from the Department for Recruitment, Support and Academic Mobility of foreign students);
- Color photo **strictly** measuring 3x4 cm.

A passport submitted by a foreign citizen must not expire earlier than 6 months after the visa expiration date.

Each time you renew your visa, you will need to register for migration again. For this, contact the Department for Recruitment, Support and Academic Mobility of foreign students.
